



GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE « BIEN-AIR 7-DAY FREE TRIAL PROGRAM »

These terms and conditions will govern your participation in the "Bien-Air 7-day free trial program". You are deemed to have read and consented to these terms and conditions prior to entering into this program.

All participants agree to be bound by the following terms and conditions, throughout the term of the program:

1. The organiser of the program is Bien-Air Dental S.A.
2. The duration of the special promotion and of the program shall be left to the discretion of the organiser.
3. To be eligible to participate in this program, the participant must:
 - a. Be a dentist
 - b. Be in possession of a valid credit card with accessible funds
 - c. Reside in the following countries: Canada, France, Germany, Italy, Portugal, Spain, Switzerland, UK, USA
 - d. According to the General Terms and Conditions, the program is only available in the following countries: Canada, France, Germany, Italy, Portugal, Spain, Switzerland, UK, USA
4. The program entitles dentists to trial a Tornado turbine or an EVO.15 1:5L contra-angle for up to seven (7) days.
5. A maximum of one (1) handpiece (Tornado or EVO.15 1:5L) is allowed per dental surgery or clinic.
6. The handpiece must be returned after the seven (7) day trial period upon which the dentist can decide if they would like to purchase the product.
7. If the handpiece is not returned or returned damaged, Bien-Air Dental S.A. reserves the right to charge the instrument at its commercial value, including transportation and recall costs.
8. Bien-Air Dental S.A. reserves the right to amend its prices and delivery costs at any time, and to cancel any contracts that contain errors in their wording, printing or calculations.
9. Our General Terms and Conditions of Sale apply when purchasing the Tornado and/or the EVO.15 1:5L contra-angle.
10. Bien-Air Dental S.A. reserves the right to adapt or modify these General Terms and Conditions at any time.
11. These General Terms and Conditions and, in general, the rights and obligations resulting from the relationship with Bien-Air Dental S.A., are subject to Swiss law (Code of obligations), with the exception of any foreign rights or agreement, in particular with the exception of the United Nations Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods.

The sole competent court for any disputes arising from or in connection with this agreement is in Biel/Bienne, Switzerland.
